


Colour in the picture of baby Jesus in the manger. Who is missing? Who else would have been there? Draw them near Jesus in his manger.


'You will know me from my smell ... which will be smelled in the temple, used to offer thanks and praise to God. I point to a high priest, who is acceptable and pleases God.'
